## RayUnion Golf Tournament Sunday May 22, 2022

- 1) USGA rules apply unless superseded by local or tournament rules
- 2) Local rules apply unless superseded by tournament rules
- 3) Tournament will be a modified "Bramble"
  - a) Par 3's and 4's:
    - i) All players will hit a tee shot
    - ii) Team captain will chose the best tee shot and all players on that team will hit from the best shot placement
    - iii) Each player will play their own second and further shots into the
    - iv) Team will record best 2 scores for the hole
  - b) Par 5's
    - i) All players will hit a tee shot
    - ii) Team captain will chose the best tee shot and all players on that team will hit from the best shot placement
    - iii) Team captain will chose the best second shot and all players on that team will hit from the best second shot placement
    - iv) Each player will play their own third and further shots into the hole
    - v) Team will record best 2 scores for the hole
- 4) Teams will be determined by a blind draw:
  - a) 6 players 2 threesomes
  - b) 7 players 1 threesome, 1 foursome
  - c) 8 players 2 foursomes
  - d) 9 players 3 threesomes
  - e) 10 players 2 threesomes, 1 foursome
  - f) Going forward with more players, every effort will be made to have an even number of players on all teams (ex. 18 players 6 threesomes) and will be set by the tournament director
  - g) Teams will be solely made up of former crewmembers of the USS Ray or their guest (guests must be registered with the official RayUnion muster list)
- If there is a mix of teams (ex. 2 threesomes and 3 foursomes), the threesomes will get a fourth shot. Each player on the threesome will alternately get an extra shot per hole. Example player A will get an extra shot on holes 1, 4, 7, 10, 13, and 16, player B will get an extra shot on holes 2, 5, 8, 11, 14, and 17 and player C will get an extra shot on holes 3, 6, 9, 12, 15, and 18. The player with the extra shot will play the first and last shot off the tee and each of the best ball shots (e.g. the second shots on par 3's and 4's and the second and third shots on par 5's).
- 6) Men 59 and under will play from the White tees. Men 60-69 will play from the Gold tees. Men 70 and over and all women will play from the Red tees. Players may chose to play from a tee box that is further back but must play from the same tee box for the entire round (ex. A 70 year old man may start on the Gold tees but must play the Gold tees for the entire 18 holes).

- 7) Unless USGA or local rules allow a better lie, Captain's choice ball placement must be within 1 club length of the original shot no closer to the hole unless the choice is from the green. If Captain's choice ball is in the rough, other players' ball placement must be in the rough. If Captain's choice ball is in a hazard, other players' ball placement must be in the hazard. If the Captain's choice ball is on the green, other players' ball placement must use the same ball placement as the chosen ball.
- 7) Prizes will be determined by the tournament director after registration is complete. Prizes may include but are not limited to cash, gift cards, trophies, etc.
